Firefighter/Paramedic

North Kitsap Fire and Rescue is establishing eligibility lists for the positions of Entry Level Firefighter/Paramedic and Lateral Entry Firefighter/Paramedic.

Annual Salary: \$52,931 (entry level) to \$88,218 (top step) plus benefit package.

Duties of the Position: This is a full time, union-represented position. Principle duties include serving as a first responder providing emergency medical aid, general firefighting and rescue activities, station and apparatus upkeep, and public education participation. Firefighter/paramedics are assigned to a 24 hour shift schedule, utilizing a 48 hours on/96 hours off rotation.

Fire District: North Kitsap Fire and Rescue serves the communities of Kingston, Hansville, Suquamish, Indianola, and Miller Bay. Our service area is approximately 46 square miles with a population of approximately 20,000. We are a combination fire department, utilizing career and volunteer personnel to respond out of four staffed and one volunteer fire station. Our 2017 call volume was 3,052 incidents, with approximately 64% of them being medical responses. For more information please visit our website at www.nkfr.org.

Minimum Requirements

Entry Level:

- Three years as a practicing paramedic
- Must possess current Paramedic certification with National Registry or Washington State certification
- High School diploma or equivalent
- Valid driver's license at the time of conditional offer
- Must complete CPAT through National Testing Network or Public Safety Testing

Lateral Entry:

- Three years as a firefighter/paramedic in a fire service career position
- Must possess current Paramedic certification with National Registry or Washington State certification
- High School diploma or equivalent
- Valid driver's license at the time of conditional offer

- ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-700, ICS-800
