<u>Meeting Minutes</u>: A review of the meeting minutes from April 28th, 2025, Regular Board Meeting was conducted. The minutes were approved as presented.

Payroll: The May Payroll of \$547,898.02 was presented to the board. The payroll was approved as presented.

<u>Blanket Voucher Approval (BVA)</u>: The following batches were presented for approval: **BVA Batch #5.1** for \$269,457.24, **BVA Batch #5.2** for \$68,926.91, and **BVA Batch #5.3** for \$96,930.04. Commissioner Pearson provided an overview of the expenses.

<u>Public Comment:</u> Chair Huntington called for public participation. There was none.

Chiefs Report:

Chief LaGrandeur: Kitsap County Fire Marshal Dave Lynam is expected to receive a final decision from the County Commissioners this evening regarding the proposed fire code changes. Two significant proposed changes include: 1) requiring additional space for ladder truck access for commercial structures and aerial apparatus access for buildings over 30 feet in height, and 2) requiring additional access roads for housing developments exceeding 250 homes, regardless of the presence of approved fire sprinkler systems.

At the most recent Kitsap 911 Board of Directors meeting, three funding formula options were presented in response to concerns that the initial proposal significantly increased user agency fees. These options represented funding methodologies only and did not include full budget analyses. Options one and three were rejected due to either excessive increases to user agency fees or unsustainable reductions in the formula. The Board directed Kitsap 911 to conduct a full analysis of option two, which still includes user fee increases but to a lesser extent than the original proposal. This analysis will be presented to the Strategic Advisory Board on May 27, with a full presentation to the Board of Directors scheduled for June 3. The timeline is structured to support budget approval in September.

Chief Buchanan: The call volume for April 2025 was 293 incidents. Of those, 66% were EMS, and 34% were non-EMS. We had one structure fire in our district in April. We had 114 transports in April, with no transports going to St. Anthony Hospital in Gig harbor. The total hours of overtime/comp time earned in April was 795 hours. May 1st, we have multiple members receiving a step increase. FF Klunk will move to top step FF, and FF Vernik, Schoonmaker, and Bergstrom will move to FF step 3.

Chief Abrigo: The fiber optic upgrade is in progress. The conduit was buried last week, and we are waiting for KPUD to pull the line. The engine and transmission were changed out in Aid 85 for the refurbishment project and CZ Auto Detail just completed detailing the rig over the weekend. We are waiting to upgrade the inside of the cab, and we will then be able to put it in service by the end of the month. Marine 81 has returned from North River. We are finishing up a few minor items and then we will be able to place it back in service. The new engine should have its inspection on May 18th or 20th with an anticipated delivery date of late June, or early July.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Commissioner Huntington announced that the Board will meet in an executive session pursuant to **RCW 42.30.110 (1)(g)** to evaluate the qualifications of an applicant for public employment or to review the performance of a public employee. The executive session will be for 44 minutes.
