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Washington State Risk Management Group—Chair Gregory stated that the Fire Chief and Commissioner Board received a thank you letter for attending the Active Shooter Preparedness Seminar on February 8, 2017. Chair Gregory asked who attended the seminar. A/C Moran stated that Captain Steve Engle was the person who attended the seminar.	
• ESO Incident Reporting System—A/C LaGrandeur stated that the crew started using the ESO Incident Reporting System at midnight on February 1, 2017. It has gone without a hitch for the most part. We have had a few issues but nothing crippling for incident reporting. A/C Lagrandeur stated that we had a bit of advantage because Central Kitsap Fire & Rescue & Poulsbo Fire Departemt started using ESO Incident Reporting System on January 1, 2017. The two fire departments worked out a few of the bugs especially with Cencom. It is very different than the system that we have been using. We are trying to figure out exactly what it does and figuring out what reports we can create, etc. A/C LaGrandeur stating that so far we are happy with the product.	
• <u>Blue Water Inn Fire</u> —A/C LaGrandeur stated that we had a fire at the Blue Water Inn. A/C LaGrandeur stated that B/C Murray was the incident commander on that fire and that the crew did an outstanding job. All things consider, in his personal opinion, it was the best operation that he has ever seen in this department; it was phenomenal. A/C LaGrandeur stated that there was no injuries with either the crew or the citizens. A/C LaGrandeur stated that the fire is under investigation by the fire marshal department and that the investigator came today to talk to the crew. Commissioner Stewart stated that he heard a very nice compliment from Chief Griffin about the fire, the response and how well it was put out. Discussion ensued.	
• <u>Hazmat Operations Testing</u> —A/C Moran stated that hazmat operations testing will be occurring this weekend at St. 81 for the last academy. They have to pass a written test on Friday night and a practical test on Saturday. Hopefully, we will get through that; it has been a real sticking point over the last year, the hazmat portion for the Firefighter I certification. We will see how it goes on Saturday.	

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• New Engines—A/C Moran stated we have received all the tools and equipment hose for the new engines last week. A/C Moran stated that we still have training for staff before we put the new engines in service. The crew will have to do a road test drive and take it to the drill ground to do some pumping before we put it in service. A/C Moran stated we are aiming to put the new engines in service by the end of March, 2017. Commissioner Neupert asked if the top leak situation got resolved. A/C Moran stated that it has been completed and done.	
Old Engine—Commissioner Neupert asked how much did we get for the old engine from Stokes. A/C Moran stated that he hasn't had a chance to talk to Robert. A/C Moran stated that he will give the Board an update at the next meeting.	
• Surface Pro 4—Chief Smith stated that A/C Moran is in the process of ordering the Surface Pro 4 for the Board.	
• Fire that occurred 20 years ago—Chief Smith stated that a fire that occurred 20 years ago, may be an issue here in the near future. Chief Smith stated that Bay View Estates has not made the necessary changes to be in compliance according to the county ordinance. Chief Smith stated that he would like the Board's support to make Bay View Estates make the changes or bring in the County Fire Marshal to enforce the county ordinance. Commissioner Neupert stated that he feels that we should just turn it over to the Fire Marshal. Chief Smith stated that he would like to be able to work together with the Fire Marshal in resolving this issue.
