Chief's Report—	
• Expense Budget for 2018—Chief Smith stated that he is still working on the Expense budget. Chief Smith stated that he would like to set up a date to meet with the Budget Committee. The Budget Committee agreed to meet on Wednesday, December 13, 2017 in the afternoon.	
Union Contracts—Chief Smith stated that they are still working on union contracts. Chief Smith is hoping to get it resolve maybe by the end of the week.	
Executive Session Chief Smith requested an Executive Session at the end of the meeting to discuss an issue regarding union contract negotiations.	
• Operation Report: November call volume—A/C LaGrandeur stated that we had 270 response calls in November, 2017 and that 61% of those calls were EMS calls and 39% were fire calls. A/C LaGrandeur stated that so far we have a total of 2,517 calls to date. A/C LaGrandeur stated that the projected calls for 2017 is 3,082 based on current calls and projections based on last year's numbers. A/C LaGrandeur stated that we had 296 calls in December, 2016.	
Overtime Report—A/C LaGrandeur stated that the overtime hours in November, 2017 was 197.5 hours; a significant drop from October which was 551 calls. A/C LaGrandeur stated that the 197.5 hours doesn't include any hours for wildland deployments.	

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•	<u>Winter Weather Workshop</u> —A/C LaGrandeur stated that he attended a Winter Weather Workshop at DEM in November. A/C LaGrandeur stated the predictions for weather are similar to last year; heavy rain, possible snow and several wind events are predicted.	
•	Communication using the Emergency Management Assistance Compact System (EMAC)—Chief Smith stated that there is a problem with communication with California with using the EMAC system. Chief Smith stated that we were going to send two strike teams to California; however, they got cancelled. Discussion ensued. Chief Smith stated that we need to do something different in the future i.e. possibly changing the EMAC System. Chief Smith stated that he has a meeting in January, 2018 to discuss the gaps in the process of communications from state to state.	
	Recruit Academy/EMT—A/C Moran stated that on November 6 2017 and November 7, 2017 for Live Fire Training for the recruits. A/C Moran stated that the first day was spent introducing the recruits to live fire for their first time. A/C Moran stated that the second day was for live fire testing for IFSAC in the morning and the afternoon spent in search and rescue prop. A/C Moran stated that both days was a huge success with all 12 recruits passing the IFSAC live fire test. IFSAC written test was held here at NKFR on December 6, 2017/ A/C Moran stated that the results should be available by the end of December.
