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Chief LaGrandeur: Reported the call volume for August was 316 incidents. Of those, 74% were EMS, 26% were non-		
EMS. There was one structure fire in our district in August. There were no injuries to personnel or the occupants. We		
had 124 transports in August, which does not include transports by mutual aid agencies or airlifts. Overtime was high		
at 1,684.50 hours which 770.50 hours were due to mobilizations and will be reimbursed. We have been working		
through the requirements for the new vaccination mandate. We continue to send resources on wildland		
deployments, which the activity has been very high again this summer but we anticipate it will slow down as we go		
into fall. The testing process for the open firefighter/paramedic position begins tomorrow, September 13 <sup>th</sup> and we		
are hopeful to fill the position soon.		
Chief Abrigo: Reported that Olympic Roofing set a tentative date of November 1 <sup>st</sup> for the roofing project to begin		
and that they are still having difficulties getting all the materials needed due to shortages. Robert Lacey and Aaron
