North Kitsap Fire & Rescue (NKF&R) seeks additional applications for well-qualified and motivated candidates to be temporarily appointed by the Board of Fire Commissioners (BOFC) to a vacant Fire Commissioner position, serving from April 22, 2024 through December 2025. A general election is scheduled for this position in November 2025 that will determine who serves for the rest of this position's term, beginning in January 2026 through December 2029. Fire department experience is not necessary for this position.

QUALIFICATIONS

REQUIRED:

- U.S. Citizen and at least age 18
- Registered voter residing within the boundaries of NKF&R for at least 30 days
- No felony convictions unless the individual has had his or her civil rights restored subsequent to the conviction
- No contractual conflict of interest with NKF&R

PREFERRED:

- Experience in a public or private agency that includes oversight of organizational budgets, development of policies and strategic plans and understanding of service delivery from the perspective of medical care and/or emergency response.
- Excellent verbal and written skills, including review of complicated documents and accurate representation of community interests/priorities.
- Documented involvement with the community served by NKF&R, demonstrating an understanding of how to accurately represent community interests/priorities over both short and long term.
